

## Lisa Henthorne Joins WATER STANDARD Team



Lisa Henthorne, world recognized expert with more than 20 years of experience in technology assessment, pre-treatment evaluation, pilot testing and design optimization for seawater desalination systems, joined the WATER STANDARD team as Sr. Vice President and Chief Technology Officer.

In 1997, Henthorne helped develop and implement a research and training program for the Middle East Desalination Research Center. She led the International Research Advisory Council composed of 20 representatives from 14 countries in periodic workshops to assist in development of their research agenda. Lisa has also served as a trusted technical advisor on many of the most challenging desalination projects in the Middle East, Australia, North America, and Asia including the innovative large-diameter seawater reverse osmosis (SWRO) plant for Power Seraya in Singapore, the first commercial 16-inch diameter SWRO in the world. In Australia, Lisa was a desalination technical advisor for Sydney Water, and the Cities of Melbourne and Perth Australia in development of their large-scale seawater desalination plants.

She holds three U.S Patents in water treatment technology and currently serves as the President of the International Desalination Association (IDA).
